Shannon Stewart became Executive Director & CEO of Inspiration Corporation in 2011, after serving as the organization's Chief Operating Officer since 2005. Annually, Inspiration Corporation helps 3,000 people, affected by homelessness and deep poverty, improve their lives and increase self-sufficiency through meals, supportive services, employment training and placement and housing. Shannon has been working in the employment and training field since 1992 and the homeless services field since 1994. She has actively participated in the city's Plan to End Homelessness from its inception, serving early on as a member of the Planning Council and twice as co-chair of the HUD Evaluation Tool Committee. Shannon currently serves on the Plan 2.0 Employment Task Force and the Service Providers Commission Executive Committee.
