David is currently the Vice President, Housing Administration for Thresholds. In his professional career at Threshold David has created access to over 600 new units of housing through numerous project developments such as HUD SHP, CHA-PRA, Master Lease and other innovative housing projects. In 2007 Thresholds through David's leadership initiated the Housing Administration department starting with a staff of 3 including himself to a staff of 15 including the Director of Housing, 2 Housing Specialist Team Leader, 6 Housing Specialists, 2 Housing Locator/Inspector, and a Housing Administrator, Service Integration Specialist, Service Coordinator and Residential Accountant. David is certified as an Assisted Housing Manager, Tax Credit Asset Management, and Housing Quality Standards Inspector.

David has been participating in the CAEH and the Chicago CoC for over 13 years as a Supportive Housing Service Provider and has served on many CoC committees. Committees include, HMIS, HNV, Evaluation Instrument Sub-Committee, Advocacy, CRS Task Group HEARTH Funding Opportunities Task Group and numerous Adhoc groups. David currently participates on the Coordinated Access Steering Committee, CRS Managing Entity Advisory Board, Co-Chair of the Service Providers Commission, and Representative of the SPCEC on the Planning Council. Other Chicago homeless community involvement David participated as part of the lead team in the 100,000 Homes Rapid Results Campaign.

Most recently David was successful in coordinating various Chicago CoC homeless service providers in community wide application to create 450 units housing to be considered by HUD to fund a Collaborative Scattered Site PSH project for Chronic Homeless Individuals.

In addition to his Chicago CoC participation, David is an Board Member of the Supportive Housing Providers Association (SHPA) and participants on the Illinois Inter-Agency Council on Ending Chronic Homelessness.

Although David is an employee of Thresholds he participates on these committees as a representative to the homeless and housing system and will make decisions that are in the best interest of the system.

David, would be an excellent asset and representative to the Chicago Alliance Board of Directors. His ability to elicit a collaborative process and maintain an objective vision of the Chicago homeless system makes him an excellent candidate for the board.
