



## **Chicago Alliance to End Homelessness Plan Advisory Committee Committee Description**

The Plan Advisory Committee is a joint committee of the Consumers and Service Providers Commissions of the Chicago Alliance. The Committee consists of three members elected from the Consumers Commission, three members elected from the Service Providers Commission, and one representative appointed by each of the constituency groups/caucuses. The Committee will meet monthly or as needed.

### **Leadership of the Plan Advisory Committee**

1. *Chairperson:* The Committee's Chairperson will be responsible for leading meetings, managing group participation, and working with staff to plan committee activities. Chairs can be elected from Committee members representing any Commission or constituency groups/caucuses.
2. *Ambassadors:* The Committee will elect two Ambassadors – one for the Consumers Commission and one for the Service Providers Commission. Ambassadors will be responsible for reporting back to the respective Commissions on the activities of the Plan Advisory Committee.

### **Role of the Plan Advisory Committee**

1. Provide advice and consent on the activities of the Alliance in pursuing the implementation of Chicago's Plan to End Homelessness.
2. Represent the work of implementing Chicago's Plan to End Homelessness in other Alliance Commissions and Committees, to other homeless service providers, to the media, and with policymakers.
